It centers those that have been marginalized within Black liberation movements. It is a tactic to (re)build the Black liberation movement."




### INTERSECTIONALITY



### REVIEW

- Technologies are social because of the social actors involved in its creation, production and ultimate use
- Intersectionality is a lens to examine how technologies are failing some users over other users as we turn our attention to systemic power relations that maintain and reproduce particular discriminations





# INEQUALITIES REPRODUCED AND REINFORCED THROUGH THESE TECHNOLOGIES

The Verge

Twitter's disappearing tweets, called Fleets, are now available for everyone

But users also identified a range of other issues with the feature:

- fleets allow users to bypass direct message settings because they go directly to inboxes, even if DMs are closed
- people have reported being able to tag users who have blocked them
- · users are not notified if someone else shares their tweet into a fleet

### TECHNOLOGICALLY-FACILITATE VIOLENCE

- anonymous trollingmen
  - some experienced more than others
  - those with strong offline support networks were better equipped to ignore/move on
- other forms of violence
  - violence from white feminists, transexclusionary feminists who are identifiable online
